

Harby Village Hall 100 Club Rules



Purpose

The purpose of the Harby Village Hall 100 Club is to raise funds to maintain and develop facilities for Harby Village Hall as a resource for the community.

Rules

1. The club will be run in annual cycles starting in August, and will hold monthly draws with a 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize.
2. For a cost of £60 per year (i.e. £5 per draw) you will be allocated a number which will be entered into each draw (the same number each time). An individual can buy more than one number.
3. The fee for each number will be paid in advance and is not refundable. Each number is deemed to have been reserved from the first draw it is entered in until the end of that annual cycle and is not transferable. Members' numbers will only be entered if their subscription has been paid.
4. Payment can be made by BACS, cash or by cheque (made payable to Harby Village Hall). Individuals can join at any time during the year by paying for the remaining months of the annual fee.
5. Members and non-members will be able to buy additional numbers for a single draw from the organisers up to the evening before the draw. Such purchases will be cash-only and the number will be allocated for that draw only.
6. The prizes will total 60% of the income for that month, and will be apportioned as: 1st prize of 30%, 2nd prize of 20% and 3rd prize of 10% of income. For example, if there are 100 members, the monthly income would be £500 and would generate prizes of £150, £100 and £50.
7. The 100 Club is a registered small society lottery and is open to all Harby residents, their friends and family. Members must be aged 18 or over.
8. The draw shall be organised by members of the Village Hall Committee on the first Wednesday of each month (or as close as possible to this day). Each draw will be conducted in the presence of three or more persons including at least one Village Hall Committee Member and one independent member of the public.
9. The winners will be paid by cheque, which will be delivered to the address on the membership application form within one week of the draw.
10. The name and numbers for each month's winners will be posted on the Village Hall website and Facebook page, unless requested otherwise.
11. The 100 club will be run by the Harby Village Hall Committee. In case of any dispute the decision of the committee is final.
12. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into Village Hall funds after six months.
